Evelyn – for listening and being open to being convinced

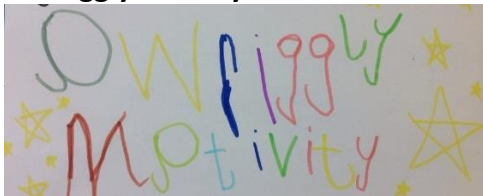
Amelie – for making huge efforts with her handwriting
